Hello new puppy owner!!

I am attaching my New Puppy Pamphlet for information on your first few days with the new puppy. Please read through it and I hope it helps with those questions you've been thinking of asking.

As far as what to bring with you if you are traveling home with the new puppy, I suggest a bottle of water and container for the puppy to drink, another container for some food on the trip, and a crate in your car, as I do not recommend traveling with a pet that is loose in the car. In the crate you can have a couple of toys and a small chew bone. You can bring some dry paper towels and some wet ones, just in case. A collar and leash for walking would be good to stop for potty time if your trip is a longer one.

At home you should have a crate large enough for your dog when grown, two bowls, one for food and one for water. Plenty of toys and chew bones will help greatly. I do not recommend an expensive bed or pad until your puppy is over the chewing stage.

There are other suggestions in the pamphlet, so be sure and read that. Good luck, and know that I am always here for questions, issues and of course for future pictures along the way!
